- H1. *Chablis, Domaine des Îles, France* £23.20
Gerard Tremblay produces the most elegant style of Chablis - very mineral, clean and unspoilt by excessive oak. An old fashioned & worthy style. Good honeyed fruit on the nose with crisp, steely fruit on the palate, gives a wine of great finesse.
- H2. *Sancerre, Domain Daulny, Loire France* £18.50
A pungent, up front bouquet of grassy, meadow flowers wafts from the nose, while the palate displays plenty of crisp freshness and apply/grapefruit acidity.
- H3. *Marquis de Goulaine Muscadet Sevre et Maine, Sur Lie, France* £15.45
Made in the traditional method, with ageing on the lees taking up to a year to add richness and complexity to the wine. Green fruit, melon and citrus come through on the nose with subtle yeasty floral complexity and green apple finish.
- H4. *Casa Silva Reserva Chardonnay, Chile* £15.75
A fresh and enchanting bouquet of apple, white peach, coconut and a hint of spice. On the plate, it charms with its pure fruit flavours, subtle spice and supreme balance.
- H5. *Santa Ema Sauvignon Blanc, Chile* £12.50
Wonderfully dry and crisp with intense citrus notes, green apples, pear and a tangy finish which get the taste buds going.
- H6. *Soave Classico DOC, Italy* £15.45
Intense yet delicate aromas of white fruits and flowers. Dry, medium-bodied and fresh with a touch of almonds, typical of the Garganega.

- H7 *Gobillard Brut Tradition NV* £32.35
Gobillard's lovely house Champagne- lively, light, fresh, very easy but elegant- a textbook example of the Non-Vintage style.
- H8 *Gobillard Rose 1^{er} Cru NV* £37.75
Thierry Gobillard's Flagship wine, a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay: It's delicate pale salmon pink in colour and has a youthful, vigorous mousse. In the mouth it has a complex palate of summer fruit and a long finish- superb stuff.

- H9 *Santa Ema Merlot, Chile* £12.50
Garnet red with purple hues. Intense aromas of strawberries and blackberries combine nicely notes of black pepper and dried fruits. A juicy and silky mouthful
- H10 *Beronia Rioja Crianza, Spain* £14.75
Red garnet in colour, with strawberry and blackberry aromas. Smooth and silky on the palate with fresh cherry fruit, chocolate and coffee flavours.
- H11 *Henry Fessy, Beaujolais-Villages, France* £14.95
Fruity, floral and slightly spicy, this is a great light and easy drinking red wine for a summer afternoon.
- H12 *Chianti Colli Senesi DOCG, Italy* £19.50
Brick red in colour with a nose of cherries and spice. Medium body and mild tannins make it all too easy to drink.
- H13 *Casa Silva Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile* £15.75
The nose is scented with blackcurrant leaves and liquorice. The Palate is opulent with cassis, blackberry, spicy oak and chocolate. The tannins are supple and well integrated, leading to a lovely balanced wine
- H14 *Fleurie Tradition Domaine De La Madone, France* £20.75
Brick red in colour with a nose of cherries and spice. Medium body and mild tannins make it all too easy to drink.

House Wine

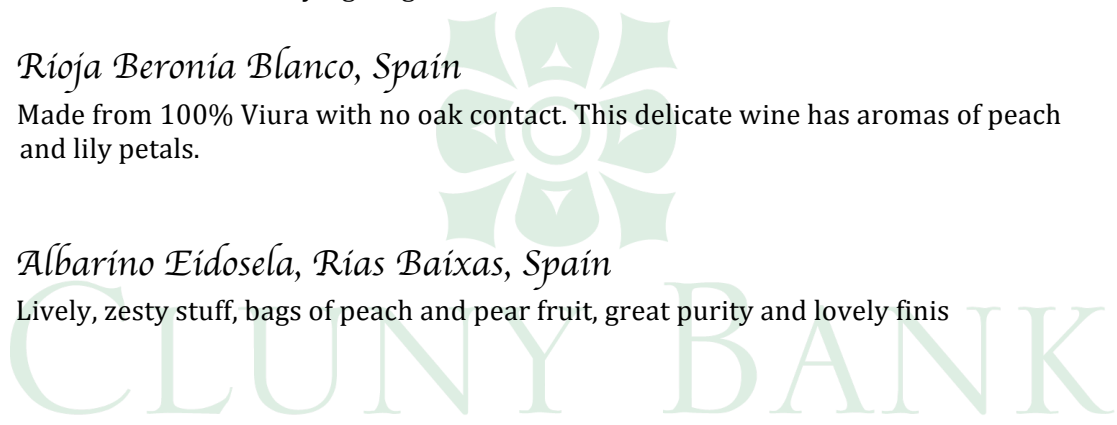
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1. *Paarl Heights Shiraz, South Africa* £18.75
Fruit cake and dark, smokey nuances on the nose with ripe, juicy fruit and pepper notes on the palate
2. *Vina San Esteban Classic Sauvignon Blanc, Chile* £17.95
Fresh lime and floral aromas on the nose. The palate is beautifully balanced with bright acidity and delicate body

3. *Quara Estate Torrontes, Argentina* £24.95
Great aromatic intensity with tropical fruit, citrus and floral notes. Very fresh with a sweet entrance and lively acidity, a long finish
4. *Crios Torrontes, Dominio Dl Plata, Mendoza, Argentina* £28.95
Beautiful pale green-yellow. Delicate, scented aromas and flavours of white peach, ripe grapefruit and white flowers. On the plate, it has a beautiful structure, acidity and minerality. Plenty of body for a wine that shows such delicate aromas and flavours.
5. *Rowlands Brook Chardonnay, Australia* £28.75
Ripe pineapple and melon flavours of the distinctive Chardonnay grape. Typical of The fruit driven style that has made Australian wine so popular.
6. *Mitchell Growers Semillon, Clare Valley, Australia* £31.40
Clean and fresh on the palate with attractive, lemony fruit. The extra dimension of oak, a few years cellaring develops the complexity and buttery character.
7. *Bremerton Verdelho, Australia* £36.40
Excellent, light, fresh and vibrantly tropical with pear and refreshing citrus. The Verdelho grape is from Madeira originally and was taken to Australia to try and mimic Madeira wines.
8. *Sierra Grande Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile* £19.25
Bright yellow with green hues. This classy and vibrant Sauvignon Blanc offers fragrant notes of lemon blossom combined with aromas of grapefruit, pineapple and fresh herbs. The palate is elegant and fresh with a balanced natural acidity and a pleasant finish.
9. *Tabali Reserve Viognier, Chile* £24.95
This aromatic and subtle Viognier presents aromas of citrus and floral notes. On the palate gentle floral, honeyed and citrus flavors mingle with a soft rounded texture and great purity.
10. *Emiliana Reserva Reislung, Chile* £20.65
Bright lime and grapefruit on the nose. The palate has a limey richness, with minerality And a lovely mouth watering lime zest, off dry finish.
11. *Chablis Domaine Sequinot-Bordet, France* £39.65
The nose is reminiscent of the scented freshness of a lovely summer's morning. The taste is perfect harmony of maturity, mellowness and vivacity. The flowers and fruit reappear, enhanced by charming biscuity notes.

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12. *Pouilly Fume, Domaine Sebastien Treuillet, France* £37.60
A soft nose of peaches and gooseberries with a touch of earth complements what is a nice rounded wine.
13. *Etienne Barret, Crozes Hermitage Blanc, France* £38.00
This is a delicious wine with a clean, slightly floral nose and hints of apple on the palate. It is smooth and medium-bodied, with a long finish. Perfect with cooked fish or simply on its own.
14. *Sancerre, Domain Bonnard, France* £32.75
Lime and mineral, cut grass and a hint of gooseberry. Fresh and dry with a crisp refreshing finish. A balanced and refreshing sauvignon blanc that is not overly herbal or oaked. A lovely balanced approach with tasty notes of lime, green apple and chives.
15. *Pinot Grigio Ancora, Italy* £19.65
From the warm growing region of Puglia in the south of Italy. The warmer climate makes for a riper, fruitier style of wine. This is lovely, bright and fruity, bursting with apple fruit, peaches and pears
16. *Verdicchio Ruviano, Italy* £20.75
Fresh, zesty, citrus aromas with a touch of nutty and stone fruit flavours. Good acidity, with ripe honeyed and herbal tones and a hint of wet stone.
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17. *Gavi La Battistina, Italy* £25.75
Super-cool single estate dry white. Aromatic, zesty, sherbety nose with apple and pear fruit, and a hint of minerality. Juicy, weighty fruit with a zippy, citric acid mouthwatering feel creating a refreshing, satisfying finish.
18. *Lawson's Dry Hills, Riesling, Marlborough, New Zealand* £33.90
Delicate lemon and jasmine on the nose with crisp green apple and lime acidity, balanced by a hint of sweetness.
19. *Cloudy Bay, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand* £49.95
Mouthwatering aromas of passion fruit and lemongrass on the nose. The palate has exceptional richness, with ripe gooseberry flavours and a hint of fresh fennel leading to a powerful crisp finish.
20. *Escarpment Pinot Gris, Martinborough, New Zealand* £34.20
Brilliant, full and powerful white which has been barrel fermented (!). Ripe pears and white stone fruit with a rich, spicy edge.

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| 21. | <i>DeMorgenzon DMZ Chardonnay, South Africa</i>
Smells of sweet vanilla and hints of almond with clean tropical fruit. Rich and full with Layers of grapefruit, apricot, white peach and vanilla. | £29.45 |
| 22. | <i>Kaapzicht Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa</i>
Good value, fruity, fresh and squeaky-clean. Aromas of freshly cut hay, orange blossom, tropical melon and peach tones; nicely balanced with a delicious tangy finish. | £26.35 |
| 23. | <i>Elgin Vintners Viognier, South Africa</i>
Orange blossom, apricots and white peach backed by gentle spice and hints of wood It starts off fresh and limey but then the typical Viognier richness and spice fill the palate. A stunning example of new world Viognier. A celebration of power, elegance and finesse with satisfying length. | £31.75 |
| 24. | <i>Rioja Beronia Blanco, Spain</i>
Made from 100% Viura with no oak contact. This delicate wine has aromas of peach and lily petals. | £21.75 |
| 25. | <i>Albarino Eidosela, Rias Baixas, Spain</i>
Lively, zesty stuff, bags of peach and pear fruit, great purity and lovely finis | £27.75 |

26. *Pablo y Walter Malbec, Argentina* £25.75
Expressive, slightly perfumed nose of violet and blackcurrant. The palate offers rich, savoury black fruit fused with a balanced, vibrant acidity giving the wine a refreshing juiciness. More violet, black raspberry and tayberry on the core that migrate to more liquorice and cherry fruit on the finish
27. *Catena Malbec, Argentina* £37.75
"Smooth-textured, layered, rich wine bordering on opulence...it has an elegant, light-on-its-feet personality. On the palate, spice notes and hint of chocolate emerge."
28. *Cranswick Estate Lakefield Shiraz, Australia* £22.25
Raspberry and stewed plums with upfront vanillin oak. A favoursome palate with savoury mulberry, black cherry and hints of liquorice spice, which merge well with lingering oak flavours and soft tannins
29. *Tempus Two Copper Series GSM, Australia* £28.95
The glorious essence of Grenache is enhanced with a touch of Mourvedre and Sangiovese. The resulting wine is not aged in wood in order to preserve the complex array of fresh and lively flavours of black cherry and soft fruit tannin. A wine of great style with both power and finesse.
30. *Hollick Cabernet Merlot, Coonawarra, Australia* £41.90
A typically smooth and complex Coonawarra Cabernet Merlot blend showing a persistent and polished palate of dark berries, peppermint and finely integrated quality oak and a silky tannin structure. Enthralling varietal Cabernet Sauvignon aromas of blackcurrants and dark cherries with the softer Merlot notes of violets, plums and dark chocolate.
31. *Bremerton Selkirk Shiraz, Langhorn Creek, South Australia* £41.25
It has a deep vibrant colour with a rich aroma of blackberries, complemented by spicy oak. The palate has many layers with full bodied berry fruit flavours, vanilla, coconut, oak and touches of spice.
32. *Trentham La Famiglia Nebbiolo, Australia* £31.25
Effectively a Barolo made in Australia. Spicy and savoury with a grippy finish. Plenty of Plums and red berry fruit with hints of strawberry. Light looking but looks lie in this case.
33. *Echeverria Merlot, Molina, Chile* £24.20
"Garnet red with purple hues. Intense aromas of strawberries and blackberries combine nicely with notes of black pepper and dried fruits. A juicy and silky mouthful that persists on the fruity finish".

34. *Echeverría Reserve Syrah, Molina, Chile* £29.35
"Deep garnet red with violet gleams. A highly aromatic Syrah remembering red fruits such as blackberries, blueberries and raspberries. Hints of bitter chocolate combine nicely with notes of black pepper, cinnamon and tobacco. A well balanced and round mouthful, with a juicy and long lasting finish"
35. *Chateau de Fleurie, Fleurie Beaujolais, France* £37.45
Aromas of dark flowers, followed by a plump, silky palate of crushed red berry.
36. *Etienne Barret, Crozes Hermitage Rouge, France* £38.75
100% Syrah with classic aromas of bramble and a little spice. Oak flavours are restrained to let the fruit shine through. Medium to full bodied and easy to drink!
37. *Château Du Breuil AC Haut Medoc, Bordeaux, France* £34.60
The wine itself exhibits a full purple colour, fresh ripe cherry fruit nose with hints of vanilla and tobacco, in the mouth there is a nice viscosity, round with plenty of autumnal fruits, balanced nicely with well structured tannins. This wine should mature well over several years.
38. *Sancerre Rouge, Domaine Bonnard, France* £38.95
Classic aromas of cherry, beetroot, underbrush and blackberry dominate. The fruit, crisp acids and fine tannins give this dry Sancerre Rouge dimension
39. *Rocca Delle Macie Vernaiolo, Chianti, Italy* £34.75
Lively ruby red with violet reflections and fruity aromas of ripe red fruits on the nose. The palate is fresh, savoury and well balanced, with good structure and excellent finish.
40. *Dogajolo Carpineto, Italy* £29.65
This is a so-called "Super-Tuscan", that contains a blend of Sangiovese (Chianti) and Cabernet Sauvignon. A powerful nose jumps out at you swiftly followed by densely flavoured palate of cherry, vanilla and spice.
41. *Salice Salentino Giardinelli, Puglia, Italy* £25.50
Modern in style with bramble fruit, raisin and dried fig aromas and a certain animal character. The palate has a touch of spice, somewhat Syrah-like, to balance the black fruit and ripe tannins – a wonderful balance of sweet ripeness and bitterness typical of the Negroamaro grape. Perfectly balanced and very appealing.

42. *Barolo Flori, Araldica, Italy* £42.75
100% Nebbiolo. Following three years aging in light oak casks, the wine. Develops a light red colour with hints of orange, the nose is complex and spicy, on the palate it is rich, full bodied with sweet tannins and a dry finish.
43. *Escarpment Pinot Noir, Martinborough, New Zealand* £49.95
Exceptional Pinot Noir with black cherry, great mellow berry fruit and sweet spicy oak.
44. *Kahurangi Montepulciano, New Zealand* £31.75
Potentially the only NZ Montepulciano? A deep rich, ruby red with cinnamon and Black forest gateaux, spicy black pepper and lingering, silky dry finish.
45. *Sacred Hill Hawkes Bay Merlot, New Zealand* £25.95
Enticing aromas of sweet, ripe black fruits mingle with hints of floral notes and oak spice. Hints of black pepper and savoury in style., the plate is soft and full bodied with cedar spice notes.
46. *Demorgenzon Syrah, Stellenbosch, South Africa* £29.45
Deep, purple core with, wide, bright, bluish tinge rim. Rich, ripe, berry fruit nose with lots of ripe, red plum. Some floral notes in the background including violets and spring blossoms. Rich and full in the mouth with tremendous youthful vigour. Layers of berry fruit with developing spice including pepper, cinnamon and vanilla. Oak hardly shows, yet it must have done its job to have such elegance and roundness at this early age.
47. *False Bay Pinotage, Breede River Valley, South Africa* £19.95
Deep garnet in colour, with dark fruit, chocolate and a hint of eucalyptus on the nose. On the palate there is a heady mix of rich fruit, chocolate and plum with soft tannins.
48. *Kaapzicht Bin 3, Cabernet Merlot, Stellenbosch, South Africa* £32.35
A juicy Cabernet/Merlot blend that is mellow and smooth almost beyond belief. Sweet ripe spiced plum and red berry fruits brushed with vanilla and cedary oak.
49. *Rust En Vrede Estate Red, Stellenbosch, South Africa* £69.95
58% Cabernet Sauvignon, 29% Shiraz, 13% Merlot – one of the finest reds in the country – try with pan-fried duck breast.
50. *Elgin Vintners Cabernet Sauvignon, South Africa* £28.65
Dark Berry fruit flavours, prominent cassis and a touch of graphite on the nose with Additional intrigue of dark chocolate and spice on the palate.

51. *Borsao Garnacha, Spain* £18.65
Juicy bramble, cherry fruit and fresh redcurrants dominate this generous, easy drinking wine. Supple tannins are balanced by good acidity and blackberry notes, with a hint of licorice and black pepper
52. *Rioja Vega del Rayo Seleccionada, Spain* £22.25
70% Tempranillo, 20% Mazuelo, 10% Graciano. A delicious modern Rioja with a deep colour and ripe plum and cherry fruit aromas. Richly flavored and substantial with fruit dominant and a smoky, spicy dimension from six months in oak.
53. *Juan Gil's "Monastrell Monastrell", Jumilla, Spain* £24.35
A dark, chunky wine. Full of blackberry and plum fruit with hints of vanilla spice and coffee. The palate is warm and rich with layers of lush spicy plum and cherry fruit, with an overlying attractive perfume. Rich, sweet tannins and a touch of chocolate on the finish.
54. *Rioja Reserva Ondarre, Spain* £32.50
An intense wine classically designed and crafted. Fruit perfumes of plums and wild blackberry with hints of dried citrus peel and raisins. The sweet vanilla and brown spices from aging in wood are well balanced. Silky and ample on the palate with an elegant finish. Still quite structured and capable of further ageing.

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Blush and Rose Wines

54. *Ancora Chiaretto Rose, Italy* £19.95
Barbera rose! Ripe and juicy with strawberry, redcurrants, plum and cherry. All wrapped up in a lovely crisp acidity.
55. *Borsao Garnacha Rosada, Spain* £26.85
Delicate pink colour, with aromas of strawberry jam. The style is dry yet commercial with some mid-palate sweetness.
56. *Kahurangi Estate Pinot Noir Rose, South Africa* £27.95
Soft, ripe and fruity with sensational strawberries and cream.

Dessert Wines

57. *Mitchell Noble Semillon, Australia* £25.50
Classic botrytis affected dessert wine displaying characteristic honey and marmalade concentrated sweet fruit balanced by crisp acid on a lingering luscious finish. Time in oak and bottle has matured the wine so it is ready to enjoy upon release.
58. *Sauternes Castlenau de Suduiraut, Bordeaux France* £36.30
Loads of rich, ripe fruit with great balancing acidity. Aged for 2 years in oak before release.
59. *Elysium Black Muscat, California* £29.25
Made from little known Orange Muscat grape...kind of like Beaume de Venise with more floral orange flavour.

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Sparkling Wines

61. *Prosecco Frizzante Spago Brut de Beritol NV, Vemeto, Italy* £26.95
Classical Prosecco! A lovely light aromatic nose (herbs, crusty bread and peaches overlaid with the characteristic warm, earthy applynote of the variety) leads to a confident, creamy, lemon-tanged palate and a bright, lively finish
62. *Graham Beck Rose Brut 2006, Robertson, South Africa* £38.25
Great salmon pink in colour makes this wine look extremely attractive. Noticeable ripe strawberries from the Pinot Noir with a creamy complexity from the Chardonnay. An explosion of raspberry fruit together with some fresh sherbet on the palate with a long fine creamy mousse.

63. *Gobillard Rose 1^{er} Cru Vintage 2005* £62.85
Thierry Gobillard's Flagship wine, a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay: It's delicate pale salmon pink in colour and has a youthful, vigorous mousse. In the mouth it has a complex palate of summer fruit and a long finish- superb stuff.
64. *Gobillard 1^{er} Cru Vintage 2005* £62.85
Gold Medal Winner, International Wine Challenge 2008. The bees-knees.

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
