Red Wine

- S1. *Alma Terramater Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile)* £4.50
Concentrated black fruit flavours and some tannin to balance.
- S2. *Water's Edge Shiraz Cabernet (Australia)* £4.50
A soft, rounded easy drinking red with well-balanced fruit flavours and soft, spicy finish.
- S3. *Vistamar Brisa Merlot (Chile)* £4.50
The ruby red wine is bursting with aromas and flavours, black cherries and sweet peppers

White Wine

- S4. *Alma Terramater Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)* £4.50
Crisp and dry with hints of gooseberries and citrus fruits.
- S5. *Waters Edge Chardonnay (Australia)* £4.50
A classic dry white wine, vibrant aromas, flavours of apple, pear and tropical fruits.
- S6. *Simply Yours Pinot Grigio (Italy)* £4.50
Mouth watering with zingy fresh fruits and citrus tones.

Rose Wine

- S7. *Waters Edge Blush /White Zinfandel (California)* £4.50
Delicate and refreshing, with a coral pink colour with soft fruit flavours of strawberries and peaches.

Prosecco

- S8. *Bortolomiol Prosecco Extra Dry Spumante* £7.95
This classical Prosecco sparkling wine is slightly sweet with a velvety taste. The bouquet exudes intense green apple and wisteria flower aromas and the taste is fresh, fruity and well balanced.

White

- H1. *Chablis Brocard, Domaine des Manants, Burgundy, France* £19.50
A full bodied wine with good, complex fruit, good long length and balance, and a clean finish.
- H2. *Sancerre, Domain Daulny, Loire France* £18.50
A pungent, up front bouquet of grassy, meadow flowers wafts from the nose, while the palate displays plenty of crisp freshness and apply/grapefruit acidity.
- H3. *Muscadet De Sevre Et Maine Sur Lie Fief De La Brie, Loire France* £11.45
A superior example of this well known wine, light dry and delicious with seafood.
- H4. *Echeverria Sauvignon Blanc, Chile* £13.50
Grassy, quaffable and clean, with grapefruit, lime and herbs.

Half Bottles

Red

- H5 *Echeverría Merlot, Molina, Chile* £13.50
Garnet red with purple hues. Intense aromas of strawberries and blackberries combine nicely notes of black pepper and dried fruits. A juicy and silky mouthful
- H6 *Rioja Vega Crianza, Spain* £18.95
From Tempranillo with a little Mazuelo and Garnacha, this smooth, soft, richly-fruited red, has spice and vanilla from 12 months in American oak.
- H7 *Chateau Chassantour, Beaujolais-Villages Lantignie, France* £18.90
A chocolaty intensity of fruit marks this wine out from the Beaujolais crowd. It comes from the relatively unknown village of Lantignie, but from a family that has made wine here for 15 generations.
- H8 *Chianti Collé Senesi DOCG, Italy* £19.50
Brick red in colour with a nose of cherries and spice. Medium body and mild tannins make it all too easy to drink.

Champagne - Half Bottles

- H9 *Gobillard Brut Tradition NV* £32.35
Gobillard's lovely house Champagne- lively, light, fresh, very easy but elegant- a textbook example of the Non-Vintage style.
- H10 *Gobillard Rose 1^{er} Cru NV* £37.75
Thierry Gobillard's Flagship wine, a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay: It's delicate pale salmon pink in colour and has a youthful, vigorous mousse. In the mouth it has a complex palate of summer fruit and a long finish- superb stuff.

House Wine

1. *Vina San Esteban Classic Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile* £17.95
Bright ruby red in colour. Cherry and smoky aromas on the nose. The palate is intense and well structured with ripe tannins.
2. *Vina San Esteban Classic Sauvignon Blanc, Chile* £17.95
Fresh lime and floral aromas on the nose. The palate is beautifully balanced with bright acidity and delicate body

White Wine

3. *La Grupa Chenin - Torrontes, Argentina* £20.75
Off dry and fruity with stone fruit, quince and hints of rose. The addition of the Chenin Calms the aromatic qualities of the Torrontes.
4. *Urban Uco Torrontes, Valle de Uco, Argentina* £28.45
Florally fragrant on the nose the bouquet of flowers is backed by dried fruits, fragrances that have immense charm. The palate is light but fruit is sweet giving a richer feel towards the back. The dried fruit spice so typical of the grape, is very much in evidence.
5. *Tempus Two Wilde Chardonnay, Australia* £28.75
It's a rich Burgundian style wine with a taste of stone fruit, then a little citrus with just a hint of apple. The layers of flavour finish with a biscuity note. The wine has great length with a subtle yeasty barrel-ferment character.
6. *Mitchell Growers Semillon, Clare Valley, Australia* £31.40
Clean and fresh on the palate with attractive, lemony fruit. The extra dimension of oak, a few years cellaring develops the complexity and buttery character.
7. *Bremerton Verdelho, Australia* £36.40
Excellent, light, fresh and vibrantly tropical with pear and refreshing citrus. The Verdelho grape is from Madeira originally and was taken to Australia to try and mimic Madeira wines.
8. *Sierra Grande Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile* £19.25
Bright yellow with green hues. This classy and vibrant Sauvignon Blanc offers fragrant notes of lemon blossom combined with aromas of grapefruit, pineapple and fresh herbs. The palate is elegant and fresh with a balanced natural acidity and a pleasant finish.

9. *Tabali Reserve Viognier, Chile* £24.95
This aromatic and subtle Viognier presents aromas of citrus and floral notes. On the palate gentle floral, honeyed and citrus flavors mingle with a soft rounded texture and great purity.
10. *Emiliana Reserva Reislung, Chile* £20.65
Bright lime and grapefruit on the nose. The palate has a limey richness, with minerality And a lovely mouth watering lime zest, off dry finish.
11. *Chablis Domaine Malandes, Burgundy, France* £42.45
A touch more intense than the 'Petit'. A slither deeper, more entertaining and satisfying.
12. *Pouilly Fume, Pabiot Domaine des Fines Caillottes, Loire, France* £33.60
A soft nose of peaches and gooseberries with a touch of earth complements what is a nice rounded wine.
13. *Vouvray La Forcine Demi-Sec, Loire, France* £24.50
Fresh and fruity, easy drinking wine made from 100% Chenin Blanc. This Vouvray ages well and is a great accompaniment to fish cooked in sauce and poultry
14. *Sancerre, Domain Daulny, Loire, France* £32.75
A pungent, up front bouquet of grassy, meadow flowers wafts from the nose, while the Palate displays plenty of crisp freshness and apply/grapefruit acidity.
15. *Pinot Grigio Ancora, Italy* £19.65
From the warm growing region of Puglia in the south of Italy. The warmer climate makes for a riper, fruitier style of wine. This is lovely, bright and fruity, bursting with apple fruit, peaches and pears
16. *Verdicchio Ruviano, Italy* £20.75
Fresh, zesty, citrus aromas with a touch of nutty and stone fruit flavours. Good acidity, with ripe honeyed and herbal tones and a hint of wet stone.
17. *Gavi La Battistina, Italy* £25.75
Super-cool single estate dry white. Aromatic, zesty, sherbety nose with apple and pear fruit, and a hint of minerality. Juicy, weighty fruit with a zippy, citric acid mouthwatering feel creating a refreshing, satisfying finish.

18. *Babich Riesling, Marlborough, New Zealand* £33.90
Floral orange blossom and limey citrus with a hint of slate on the nose. The palate is finely balanced, delicate yet intense with juicy lemon and lime, green apples and an intriguing mineral note that lingers.
19. *Cloudy Bay, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand* £49.95
Mouthwatering aromas of passion fruit and lemongrass on the nose. The palate has exceptional richness, with ripe gooseberry flavours and a hint of fresh fennel leading to a powerful crisp finish.
20. *Escarpment Pinot Gris, Martinborough, New Zealand* £34.20
Brilliant, full and powerful white which has been barrel fermented (!). Ripe pears and white stone fruit with a rich, spicy edge.
21. *DeMorgenzon DMZ Chardonnay, South Africa* £29.45
Smells of sweet vanilla and hints of almond with clean tropical fruit. Rich and full with Layers of grapefruit, apricot, white peach and vanilla.
22. *Kaapzicht Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa* £26.35
Good value, fruity, fresh and squeaky-clean. Aromas of freshly cut hay, orange blossom, tropical melon and peach tones; nicely balanced with a delicious tangy finish.
23. *Elgin Vintners Viognier, South Africa* £31.75
Orange blossom, apricots and white peach backed by gentle spice and hints of wood. It starts off fresh and limey but then the typical Viognier richness and spice fill the palate. A stunning example of new world Viognier. A celebration of power, elegance and finesse with satisfying length.
24. *Rioja Anzarena Blanco, Spain* £20.35
Really fresh and invigorating with elegant aromas of green apple, citrus fruits, pineapple and some floral hints.
25. *Albarino Eidosela, Rias Baixas, Spain* £27.75
Lively, zesty stuff, bags of peach and pear fruit, great purity and lovely finish.

26. *Trapiche Melodías Malbec, Argentina* £23.20
A rich red-coloured wine with violet hues, redolent of plums and cherries. Round in the Mouth with a touch of truffle and vanilla.
27. *Catena Malbec, Argentina* £37.75
"Smooth-textured, layered, rich wine bordering on opulence...it has an elegant, light-on-its-feet personality. On the palate, spice notes and hint of chocolate emerge."
28. *Peter Lehmann Weighbridge Shiraz, Australia* £21.90
The colour is dark cherry, the nose shows black plum, raspberry and hints of chocolate. It has good fruit depth on the palate. A wine to give immense enjoyment in its lively youth.
29. *Tempus Two Copper Series GSM, Australia* £28.95
The glorious essence of Grenache is enhanced with a touch of Mourvedre and Sangiovese. The resulting wine is not aged in wood in order to preserve the complex array of fresh and lively flavours of black cherry and soft fruit tannin. A wine of great style with both power and finesse.
30. *Hollick Cabernet Merlot, Coonawarra, Australia* £41.90
A typically smooth and complex Coonawarra Cabernet Merlot blend showing a persistent and polished palate of dark berries, peppermint and finely integrated quality oak and a silky tannin structure. Enthralling varietal Cabernet Sauvignon aromas of blackcurrants and dark cherries with the softer Merlot notes of violets, plums and dark chocolate.
31. *Bremerton Selkirk Shiraz, Langhorn Creek, South Australia* £41.25
It has a deep vibrant colour with a rich aroma of blackberries, complemented by spicy oak. The palate has many layers with full bodied berry fruit flavours, vanilla, coconut, oak and touches of spice.
32. *Trentham La Famiglia Nebbiolo, Australia* £31.25
Effectively a Barolo made in Australia. Spicy and savoury with a grippy finish. Plenty of Plums and red berry fruit with hints of strawberry. Light looking but looks lie in this case.
33. *Echeverria Merlot, Molina, Chile* £24.20
"Garnet red with purple hues. Intense aromas of strawberries and blackberries combine nicely with notes of black pepper and dried fruits. A juicy and silky mouthful that persists on the fruity finish".

34. *Echeverría Reserve Syrah, Molina, Chile* £29.35
“Deep garnet red with violet gleams. A highly aromatic Syrah remembering red fruits such as blackberries, blueberries and raspberries. Hints of bitter chocolate combine nicely with notes of black pepper, cinnamon and tobacco. A well balanced and round mouthful, with a juicy and long lasting finish”
35. *Fleurie les Saproletes, Jean Loron, Burgundy, France* £30.35
This romantically named wine is grown on pure granitic soil. It has bright red colour with violet glints and reveals irises, roses and raspberries aromas. Elegant and Silky, this is the most feminine of Beaujolais Crus
36. *Chateauneuf Du Pape, Les Galets de la Berthaudes, Rhone, France* £43.30
A rich, warm and fruity red from the Southern Rhone, excellent with red meat dishes and cheese.
37. *Château Du Breuil AC Haut Medoc, Bordeaux, France* £34.60
The wine itself exhibits a full purple colour, fresh ripe cherry fruit nose with hints of vanilla and tobacco, in the mouth there is a nice viscosity, round with plenty of autumnal fruits, balanced nicely with well structured tannins. This wine should mature well over several years.
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38. *Rocca Delle Macie Vernaiolo, Chianti, Italy* £34.75
Lively ruby red with violet reflections and fruity aromas of ripe red fruits on the nose. The palate is fresh, savoury and well balanced, with good structure and excellent finish.
39. *Dogajolo Carpineto, Italy* £29.65
This is a so-called “Super-Tuscan”, that contains a blend of Sangiovese (Chianti) and Cabernet Sauvignon. A powerful nose jumps out at you swiftly followed by densely flavoured palate of cherry, vanilla and spice.
40. *Salice Salentino Giardinelli, Puglia, Italy* £25.50
Modern in style with bramble fruit, raisin and dried fig aromas and a certain animal character. The palate has a touch of spice, somewhat Syrah-like, to balance the black fruit and ripe tannins – a wonderful balance of sweet ripeness and bitterness typical of the Negroamaro grape. Perfectly balanced and very appealing.

41. *Barolo Flori, Araldica, Italy* £42.75
100% Nebbiolo. Following three years aging in light oak casks, the wine. Develops a light red colour with hints of orange, the nose is complex and spicy, on the palate it is rich, full bodied with sweet tannins and a dry finish.
42. *Escarpment Pinot Noir, Martinborough, New Zealand* £49.95
Exceptional Pinot Noir with black cherry, great mellow berry fruit and sweet spicy oak.
43. *Kahurangi Montepulciano, New Zealand* £31.75
Potentially the only NZ Montepulciano? A deep rich, ruby red with cinnamon and Black forest gateaux, spicy black pepper and lingering, silky dry finish.
44. *Babich Hawkes Bay Merlot Cabernet, New Zealand* £33.40
The nose is brimming with blackberries, black currants and forest fruits that are joined by plum and tasty savoury notes. Liquorish and spice aromas intermingle perfectly. The palate is sweet and abundantly fruitful on entry developing complex savoury notes that mingle delightfully with the fruit. Gentle oak supports layers of cocoa and leather. The tannins are soft, the weight full-ish and the finish is long with lingering dark berry fruits.
45. *Demorgenzon Syrah, Stellenbosch, South Africa* £29.45
Deep, purple core with, wide, bright, bluish tinge rim. Rich, ripe, berry fruit nose with lots of ripe, red plum. Some floral notes in the background including violets and spring blossoms. Rich and full in the mouth with tremendous youthful vigour. Layers of berry fruit with developing spice including pepper, cinnamon and vanilla. Oak hardly shows, yet it must have done its job to have such elegance and roundness at this early age.
46. *False Bay Pinotage, Breede River Valley, South Africa* £19.95
Deep garnet in colour, with dark fruit, chocolate and a hint of eucalyptus on the nose. On the palate there is a heady mix of rich fruit, chocolate and plum with soft tannins.
47. *Kaapzicht Bin 3, Cabernet Merlot, Stellenbosch, South Africa* £32.35
A juicy Cabernet/Merlot blend that is mellow and smooth almost beyond belief. Sweet ripe spiced plum and red berry fruits brushed with vanilla and cedary oak.
48. *Rust En Vrede Estate Red, Stellenbosch, South Africa* £69.95
58% Cabernet Sauvignon, 29% Shiraz, 13% Merlot – one of the finest reds in the country – try with pan-fried duck breast.

49. *Elgin Vintners Cabernet Sauvignon, South Africa* £28.65
Dark Berry fruit flavours, prominent cassis and a touch of graphite on the nose with Additional intrigue of dark chocolate and spice on the palate.
50. *Borsao Garnacha, Spain* £18.65
Juicy bramble, cherry fruit and fresh redcurrants dominate this generous, easy drinking wine. Supple tannins are balanced by good acidity and blackberry notes, with a hint of licorice and black pepper
51. *Rioja Vega del Rayo Seleccionada, Spain* £22.25
70% Tempranillo, 20% Mazuelo, 10% Graciano. A delicious modern Rioja with a deep colour and ripe plum and cherry fruit aromas. Richly flavored and substantial with fruit dominant and a smoky, spicy dimension from six months in oak.
52. *Juan Gil's "Monastrell Monastrell", Jumilla, Spain* £24.35
A dark, chunky wine. Full of blackberry and plum fruit with hints of vanilla spice and coffee. The palate is warm and rich with layers of lush spicy plum and cherry fruit, with an overlying attractive perfume. Rich, sweet tannins and a touch of chocolate on the finish.
53. *Rioja Reserva Ondarre, Spain* £32.50
An intense wine classically designed and crafted. Fruit perfumes of plums and wild blackberry with hints of dried citrus peel and raisins. The sweet vanilla and brown-spices from aging in wood are well balanced. Silky and ample on the palate with an elegant finish. Still quite structured and capable of further ageing.

Blush and Rose Wines

54. *Ancora Chiaretto Rose, Italy* £19.95
Barbera rose! Ripe and juicy with strawberry, redcurrants, plum and cherry. All wrapped up in a lovely crisp acidity.
55. *Borsao Garnacha Rosada, Spain* £26.85
Delicate pink colour, with aromas of strawberry jam. The style is dry yet commercial with some mid-palate sweetness.
56. *Kahurangi Estate Pinot Noir Rose, South Africa* £27.95
Soft, ripe and fruity with sensational strawberries and cream.

Dessert Wines

57. *Mitchell Noble Semillon, Australia* £25.50
Classic botrytis affected dessert wine displaying characteristic honey and marmalade concentrated sweet fruit balanced by crisp acid on a lingering luscious finish. Time in oak and bottle has matured the wine so it is ready to enjoy upon release.
58. *Chateau Chartreuse Sauternes, Bordeaux France* £36.30
Light and whistle clean Sauternes sweetness in a convenient half bottle size. Shows the freshness on the finish that is such a welcome conclusion to any meal
59. *Elysium Black Muscat, California* £29.25
Made from little known Orange Muscat grape...kind of like Beaume de Venise with more floral orange flavour.

Sparkling Wines

60. *Tempus Two Pewter Blanc de Blancs, Australia* £33.80
A beautifully fresh and vibrant sparkling wine. Concentrated fruit flavours of peach passionfruit and green apple provide a fruit sweetness which is well balanced by a refreshing citrus finish. A soft fine bubble completes the wine, adding complexity and excitement.
61. *Prosecco Frizzante Spago Brut de Beritot NV, Veneto, Italy* £26.95
Classical Prosecco! A lovely light aromatic nose (herbs, crusty bread and peaches overlaid with the characteristic warm, earthy aplynotes of the variety) leads to a confident, creamy, lemon-tanged palate and a bright, lively finish
62. *Graham Beck Rose Brut 2006, Robertson, South Africa* £38.25
Great salmon pink in colour makes this wine look extremely attractive. Noticeable ripe strawberries from the Pinot Noir with a creamy complexity from the Chardonnay. An explosion of raspberry fruit together with some fresh sherbet on the palate with a long fine creamy mousse.

63. *Gobillard Rose 1^{er} Cru Vintage 2005* £62.85
Thierry Gobillard's Flagship wine, a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay: It's delicate pale salmon pink in colour and has a youthful, vigorous mousse. In the mouth it has a complex palate of summer fruit and a long finish- superb stuff.
64. *Gobillard 1^{er} Cru Vintage 2005* £62.85
Gold Medal Winner, International Wine Challenge 2008. The bees-knees.
